Codian is committed to complying with the European Directive on the Waste of Electrical and Electronic Equipment, 2002/96/EC (the WEEE directive).

On the 13<sup>th</sup> August 2005 the WEEE Directive came into force throughout the European Union. All Codian products supplied to member countries display the crossed out “wheelie bin” symbol. The WEEE directive states that the “producer” is responsible for the WEEE for each European member state.

To meet our commitments in the UK, Codian is a member of the Recycling Electrical Producers’ Industry Consortium (REPIC) and is part of REPICs’ WEEE Compliance scheme.

For other member states of the EU where Codian products are sold, the Codian partner who imports the equipment is considered the “producer” and is required to register themselves as a WEEE producer.

It is the policy of Codian to minimize its impact to the environment and fully comply with the WEEE 2002/96/EC directive and the Environmental legislation resulting from this directive in each European member state.
